SUBJECT: Reminder - Provincial Playdown Fees

In an attempt to eliminate some of the financial strain on those teams and players who are successful in moving on to represent their Zone at the Investors Group Hockey Alberta Provincials, during the 2006-2007 season, a new Provincial Playdown Entry Fee structure was established. In this structure all teams that enter Provincial Playdowns are charged an "entry" fee of one hundred fifty dollars (**\$150.00**).

The Provincial Playdown Entry Fee is used by Hockey Alberta to off-set the cost of operating the Investors Group Hockey Alberta Provincials by subsidizing the cost of medals, awards, player gifts, programs, signage, transportation of delegates and administration costs. This fee creates an opportunity for Hockey Alberta to offer a more appealing hosting package to potential Investors Group Hockey Alberta Provincials Host Associations by covering some of the costs associated with hosting such an event.

After Minor Council has completed the Provincial Draw, each Minor Hockey Association (MHA) will be invoiced \$150.00 for each team from their MHA that elected to participate in the Provincial Playdown process.
