**SUBJECT: Special Flood Recovery Program through Alberta Sport Connection**

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Following the devastating flooding that occurred in late June 2013, Alberta Sport Connection is offering a special flood recovery program to Southern Alberta members of provincial sport organizations within the province.

This funding is being offered to the non-profit/voluntary sector to provide financial assistance for flood recovery initiatives. Through the process of application, funds will be available to help with costs not covered by insurance or the Disaster Recovery Program. \$1 million is available in 2013-14 and \$3 million in 2014-15.

Please see the attached document containing information on eligibility requirements and directions for completing and submitting an application for funding.

As described in the attached document, costs covered may be associated with:

- Damage to infrastructure
- Relocation expenses
- Increased operational costs
- Increase in demand for programs and services from clientele who experience significant loss or trauma as a result of the floods.

In order to be considered for the 2013-14 funding, applications must be submitted (as per the directions in the attachment) no later than February 28, 2014. Any applications that cannot be funded within the 2013-14 budget will be carried over and considered for 2014-15.
