SUBJECT: Midget AAA Tryout Roster Procedure

After careful review the Midget AAA tryout and registration process, we have identified the need to ensure consistency moving forward with tryout requests and transfers.

Teams are to register in HCR, their 40 man roster. All players playing in exhibition games and preseason tournaments will be listed as tryout players. This is not applicable to those players skating at tryout sessions, only those players in exhibition games.

The transfers will be entered in HCR with the transfer type of "AAA" and the NTO uploaded. Once reviewed by the MHA, the Zone Admin Coordinator will "Approve (Share)" the member in HCR with its current MHA and the in which the Midget AAA is in that they are trying out for.

Once the player makes the Midget AAA team, the Zone Admin Coordinator will change the primary association to the MHA of the Midget AAA team that the player is registered with.

All players that don't make the Midget AAA team are to be released off the team in the Registry and will return to their resident LMHA. Do not uncheck the Tryout box as this will affect the player registration count.

The AMHL has declared 5 games at the beginning of the season as being Pre-Season games for the purpose of Team roster declaration.

This structure was developed to better reflect the current Hockey Alberta Regulations and to address the dates by which players are released from higher divisions. To follow the structure by which Teams in the AMHL will register.

- The first 5 game of the AMHL scheduled season have been declared as Pre-Season games for the purposes of Team roster declaration
- AMHL Teams will register a minimum of 15 players in the Registry (HCR) by their first Pre-Season game.
- Beyond the minimum 15 players registered in the Registry, teams will have access to a floating 10 player auxiliary list during the course of the 5 scheduled Pre-Season games.
- Upon commencement of the scheduled 6th league game all players will be registered in the Registry
