SUBJECT: Junior and Senior Female Player Allotments

This bulletin is intended to clarify the Player Registration process for Junior and Senior Female teams.

The Hockey Alberta Regulations state the following in Section C – Junior / Senior Female Hockey:

- 3.2 Every Player competing in the games sanctioned by HA shall be a member of a Hockey Team registered with HA and shall, prior to competing in their first League Game, be duly registered in the Registry for the current Hockey Season.
- 4.7 Junior and Senior Female Teams may register at any one time a maximum of twenty-five (25) Players. If those twenty-five (25), one (1) must be a goaltender. See Hockey Canada Playing Rule 2.2.
- 8.6 A Hockey Team may have affiliated with it one or the other of:
- (a) One (1) Hockey team from a lower Division or Category.
 - (b) Up to 19 named Players from a lower Division or Category.

In addition, please make note of the following:

- A player can participate with a Recreational Team as well as a Provincial or Non-Provincial Team, in the same season, if properly registered in the Registry for the current Hockey Season.
- Affiliation is NOT permitted from a Recreational Team to a Provincial or Non-Provincial team, and vice-versa.
- Affiliation is NOT permitted from Midget AAA to Senior Female B.
- If a player was not registered during the previous Hockey Season, they must be duly registered in the Registry for the currently Hockey Season to participate in on-ice activities with the Hockey Team and be permitted to access the National Insurance Program in the event of injury.
