SUBJECT: Junior Club Team Insurance Coverage

In past seasons, Hockey Alberta has requested that Junior B/C Club Teams register all players that did not play in the previous season to ensure they would have insurance coverage in the event of an injury that occurred during the tryout process.

We have recently received confirmation from Hockey Canada that Junior B/C Club Teams are not required to use up a player allotment for tryout players that were not registered to a Hockey Canada member in the previous season. Players engaging in tryouts for Junior B/C Club Teams will receive coverage from the National Insurance Program in the event of an injury.

Furthermore, graduating Midget players and players that were last registered to a Midget team are required to continue to wear the protective playing equipment required for the division of Midget (full-face protector) until they have been signed to a Junior team and approved as such in the Hockey Canada Registry.
