

OPERATIONAL POLICY: JUNIOR FEMALE OVERAGE PLAYERS

DATE ISSUED: October 1, 2013 LAST UPDATED: March 1, 2020

Junior Female Hockey is open to players twenty-one (21) years of age and younger in the current playing season, however overage players may be permitted to register on Junior Female Teams provided they meet the qualifications outlined herein and are approved through the proper process outlined in this policy.

Eligibility of Overage Players

A. Junior Female hockey is open to players twenty-one (21) years of age and younger in the current playing season. Additionally, each team can register up to four (4) overage players provided the overage player must be 22 years of age on or before December 31 of the current playing season.

Registering Overage Players

An AJFHL Team may register an overage player provided that:

A. The potential overage player must provide written confirmation from the previous team that she has completed all commitments to the previous team, i.e. return of equipment, fees, dues or time allocated to fundraising, etc.

Exceptions to this Policy

Any applications for exceptions to this policy are to be considered by the Junior Female Chairperson in consultation with the appropriate League President.
