

An Inter-Provincial Concession is a special Player movement request seeking permission for a Minor-aged Player to register, for the current season, in a neighbouring Province to where they reside.

Requests for Concessions are reviewed under the authority of Hockey Alberta's Minor Hockey Registration Regulations.

PROCESS

Step 1 – Eligibility

Concessions may be submitted when a Player:

- Is an Alberta resident and wants to register with a team outside Alberta; or
- Is a BC or Saskatchewan resident and wants to register with a team in Alberta; and
- Is seeking permission to register with a Minor Hockey Association and/ or attend a fall tryout.
 - Concessions will not be reviewed and/or considered for Players that are seeking permission to attend a camp in the spring or summer.

Concessions will not be considered for players seeking access to AA or AAA teams, except in rare circumstances at the sole discretion of Hockey Alberta. Any such request will be considered on a case-by-case basis and does not create an expectation for future requests.

Step 2 – Applications

- Applications for an Alberta resident wishing to register outside Alberta must be submitted to Hockey Alberta by the individual player (or their parent/ guardian), through Hockey Alberta's [online form](#). An application must include a written explanation of the request and reasoning.
- Applications for a BC or Saskatchewan resident wishing to register in Alberta must be submitted to their respective provincial body (either BC Hockey or Hockey Saskatchewan). If BC Hockey or Hockey Saskatchewan support the application, they will forward it to Hockey Alberta along with a written letter of support.
- Applications for the upcoming season can be submitted as of June 1.

Step 3 – Application Review

- Hockey Alberta will complete a review of an application within fourteen (14) days of submission.
- As part of the review, the Player's last registered organizations/ Team may be consulted to provide information about the Player's registration history.

Step 4 – Decisions

- Applicants will receive a written decision within seven (7) days of the completion of the review.
- If approved, the concession is valid for the current season only.
