

U11 AA HOCKEY PILOT PROJECT NOTIFICATION OF TRY-OUT FORM

Hockey Alberta will conduct a *U11AA Pilot Project* in 2021-22 that implements an amended regional hosting structure, player movement rules, league schedule and coach and player development standards. This pilot project is based largely off the final report and recommendations of the Non-Sanctioned Hockey Workgroup of last season.

We will be working in collaboration with the Northern Alberta Interlock League (Host League), the North East Alberta Hockey League, the All Peace Hockey League, and their member MHA's. We are looking to create a series of actionable recommendations that will be identified in time for implementation of a new, province wide, U11 model in the 2022-2023 season.

This completed form must be presented to the Resident Recruitment Area team that the player is trying out for before he/she is eligible to participate in the try-out camp. It is understood by all parties that should the player be chosen as a member of the designated team, the U11AA Team will notify the League and the player's Resident LMHA. If the player does not make the U11AA Team, it is the player's responsibility to notify his/her Resident LMHA whether he/she is returning or will be contacting the League for an opportunity at an additional try out.
