SUBJECT: Hockey Alberta AA Provincial Championships – Host Rotation

Hockey Alberta's AA Hockey Committee and Minor Regulations Committee have been working in conjunction since the end of the 2015/2016 season to develop a strategy to allow AA associations and teams the ability to execute a higher level of planning when awarded one of three AA Provincial Championship Tournaments.

Through discussion and recommendation, a new AA Provincial Championship Host Rotation will be implemented for use starting in the 2016/2017 season. With this host rotation, one of the four leagues will be assigned to a specific AA Provincial Championship. Associations and teams within that specific league will be allowed to submit Provincial Championship bid applications, in accordance with the Hockey Alberta Provincial Championship Bid Guidelines. Hockey Alberta will then notify the successful bidder on the awarding of the event.

This new Host Rotation Model will allow associations and teams time to better plan and tailor their bid packages for the specific event their respective League will be hosting. The model will also allow the larger associations the ability to book ice well in advance of the Provincial Championship they may be eligible to host.
