



The U18 Summer Selection Camp is a "tryout camp for the players" therefore some game rule changes will be used.

- I. The U18 Summer Selection Camp will be played under the official Hockey Canada/Hockey Alberta Rules, with the exception of the following camp adjustments.
- II. Teams must be ready to play at the appointed time.
- III. Game time:
  - a. Teams will be given a 5 minutes warm-up, beginning at the scheduled game time.
  - b. The length of all games will be 3 15 minutes, stop-time periods.
  - c. The ice will be resurfaced after every two periods.
- IV. Each team will be allowed 1 30 second time out per game.
- V. Minor penalties will be one minute in length instead of two.
- VI. Penalties:
  - a. All penalties will be called, as in the Hockey Canada Rule Book, at the discretion of the Referee. Due to the fact that the Alberta Winter Games Selection Camp is a "tryout" camp, maintaining the flow and tempo of the game is a necessity.
  - b. If the discretion of the Referee is to award a penalty that is accompanied by a Game Misconduct; that game misconduct will stand (including "Hit From Behind").
  - c. The Disciplinary Committee (Officials' Supervisor, Referee, and Hockey Alberta Representatives) will review all Game/Gross Misconduct and Match Penalties and the further participation of those players involved will be at the discretion of the Disciplinary Committee.
  - d. Any players receiving a Match Penalty for intent to injure will automatically be disqualified for the balance of the camp.
- VII. There is 1.5 hours allotted per game. We ask that the officials demonstrate good game management to ensure we remain on time. (ie. face-offs, between periods, penalties away from the play, line changes etc.)
- VIII. Team bench staff may fluctuate due to evaluation and support purposes for coaches and trainers.
- IX. Tied games shall not be broken.
